Course Descriptions

Principles Of Macro

The Principles course is the foundation of the BCA eAcademy. Delegates learn the fundamental macroeconomic concepts that move financial markets. Topics covered thoroughly in this seminar include: drivers of growth, where we are in the business cycle, role of monetary and fiscal policy, inflation, and recession. The second part of this course is about connecting the dots. Our instructors illuminate BCA's time-tested analytical framework for currencies, fixed income, and equities. Concepts covered are frequently linked back to current events and today's global macro outlook. Case studies are also an important part of the learning experience.

Geopolitics & Investing

Geopolitical analysis has become an essential component of any sound investment strategy. The following structural changes will directly impact all investment portfolios: shifts in the global balance of power from the US to China, political polarization, inequality, and growing demands for populist policies. Investors will be forced to navigate these trends and discuss them with their clients and colleagues. This course teaches geopolitics for investors. Using our Constraints-Based Method, Marko Papic will focus on the geopolitical and macroeconomic realities that constrain policymaker behavior, and outline the investment implications and consequences of their decisions. His insights on the current political outlook will also be invaluable for delegates.

Global Asset Allocation

Academic research finds that markets are, to use Paul Samuelson's phrase, "micro efficient but macro inefficient." But CIOs, asset allocators, and investment professionals often struggle to find a practical way to construct optimal multi-asset portfolios. Methods and strategies to harvest alpha from these macro inefficiencies is what the BCA eAcademy Asset Allocation course teaches participants. Delegates will also get a better understanding of how to develop and execute asset allocation strategies, as well as a firmer grasp on how investors should be positioned given prevailing market conditions.
